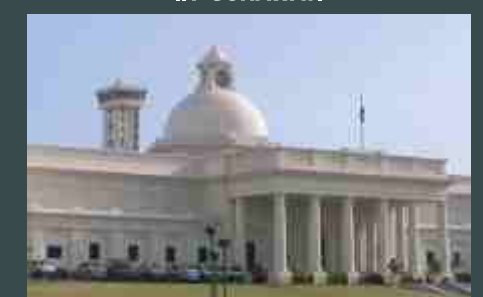

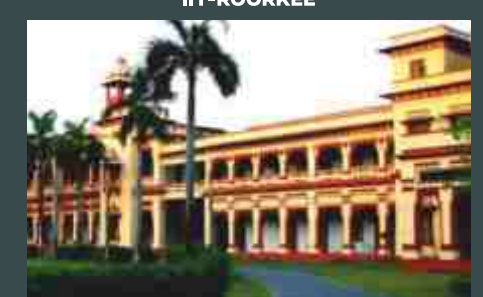

Indian Institutes of Technology (IITs) are institutions of national importance established through Acts of Parliament for fostering excellence in education. Over the years, IITs have created a world class educational platform that is dynamically sustained through quality teaching and internationally acclaimed research with excellent infrastructure and the best available minds. The faculty and alumni of IITs occupy key positions in academic and industry, both in India and abroad, and continue to make considerable impact on all sections of the society. At present, there are twenty three IITs across the country.

Indian and foreign nationals who want admission to the degree programmes have to compete in the Joint Entrance Examination (JEE). The selection procedure for admission to ISM Dhanbad is also through JEE.

Admission into various undergraduate programmes

across IITs is through the Joint Entrance Examination (Advanced). Through JEE (Advanced), IITs offer admission into undergraduate courses leading to a Bachelor's, Integrated Master's or Bachelor-Master Dual Degree in Engineering, Sciences, Architecture, or Pharmaceutics.

The admission to Undergraduate Engineering Programs at NITs, IIITs, other centrally funded Technical Institutions, Institutions funded by several participating State Governments, and several other Institutions shall include the performance in the Joint Entrance Examination, JEE (Main). The JEE (Main) will also be an eligibility test for the JEE (Advanced), which the candidate has to take if he/she is aspiring for admission to the undergraduate programmes offered by the IITs.

**Date of Examination :** The JEE (Advanced) will be held in the month of May.

**Mode of Examination :** Only Online.

### Type of Examination :

The JEE (Advanced) will have two objective type papers. Each paper will consist of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics. Duration of each paper will be 3-hours. Question papers will be in both English and Hindi. Admissions to IITs will be based only on category wise All India Rank (AIR) in JEE (Advanced) subject to the condition that such candidates are in the top 20 percentile of successful candidates of their Boards in applicable categories.

**Total number of attempts :** Two (02)

### Eligibility for JEE (Advanced) :

Candidates who wish to write JEE (Advanced) must write Paper of JEE (Main) in the month of April (tentatively). Only top 2,00,000 (or just above) candidates (including all categories) who qualify JEE (Main) will be eligible to appear for JEE (Advanced).

### Distribution of top 2,00,000 (Approx.) candidates across various categories is as follows :

- + Top 97970 (50.5%) Common Merit List
- + Top 52380 (27%) Other Backward Classes Non creamy layer OBC (NCL)
- + Top 29100 (15%) Scheduled Caste (SC)
- + Top 14550 (7.5%) Scheduled Tribe (ST)
- + 3% of the total candidates in each category are reserved for PD candidates as per Government of India norms.

The National Institutes of Technology (NITs) are a group of higher education engineering Institutes in India. On their inception decades ago, all NITs were referred as Regional Engineering Colleges (RECs) and were governed by their respective state governments. Each NIT operates autonomously which enables them to have their own curriculum. Eligibility Criteria for qualified candidates has been modified for admission purpose in JEE Main 2017. For SC/ST candidates the percentage to be considered is 65%. The following procedure will be used for selecting 2,00,000 candidates who will be eligible to appear for JEE (Advanced) based on their performance in JEE (Main)

#### JEE (Main) eligibility criteria for admission in Other Institutions :

The candidate must be eligible for the institute of his choice additionally to get admission.

If any State wants to carry out the admission process on this line, a separate merit list can be prepared on the criteria decided by the state.

Whatever is the testing pattern, basically the ultimate aim of JEE is to judge the aspirant's subject knowledge and problem-solving skills. Thus, the only requirement of this exam is to have strong basic concepts, good analytical skills, and thorough knowledge of the core concepts and extensive practice.

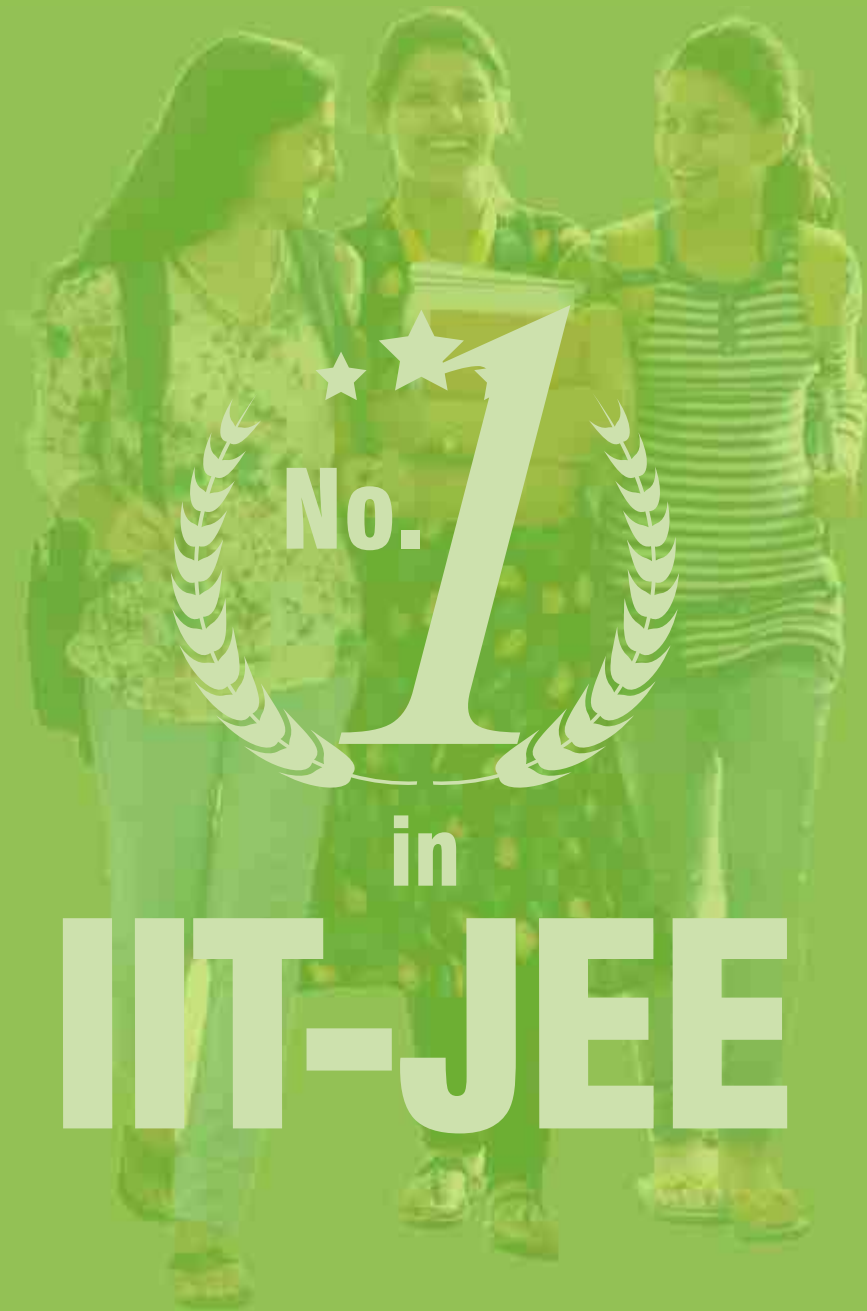

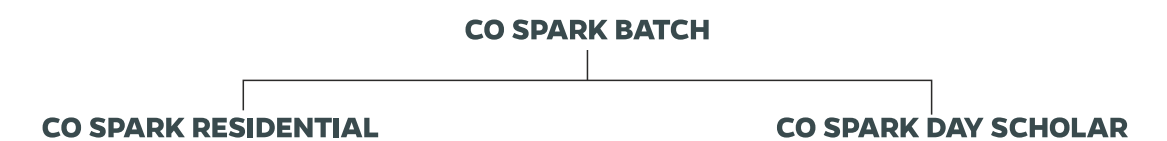

# JEE 2019

## One-Year Integrated Classroom Programme (OYICP)

### FOR XI APPEARED / XII STUDYING STUDENTS

This programme prepares the students for JEE-Advanced and JEE Main to give best desired output and performance. This 480-hours course is divided into four phases. It includes comprehensive training, practice sessions in the form of tutorial classes and also final review in Jan 2019 in the form of revision classes. This course will be completed by mid-January 2019.

Narayana always keep's itself abreast with the latest changes announced by HR ministry and IIT-JEE council. Hence CBSE had always been the part of our academic curriculum and teaching pattern. We have tried to impart more focused inputs to our students by re-structuring our course curriculum. This will take care of all the needs of the students for enhanced performance in XII Boards and competitive exams with good percentage.

### TEACHING METHODOLOGY

**STAGE I** : Coverage of Topics from CBSE level: Narayana has the system of imparting inputs through Micro-Schedule based teaching. This channelizes the efforts of our students in the right direction for desired output. We will cover all the topics of respective Phases, first from CBSE level.

**STAGE II** : Coverage of topics from JEE level: Narayana has an academic edge and proven track record over its competitors for preparing its students for JEE and Other Competitive Exams. Thus, in Stage II, we will impart JEE Level inputs of the same topics as taught in Stage I for CBSE.
